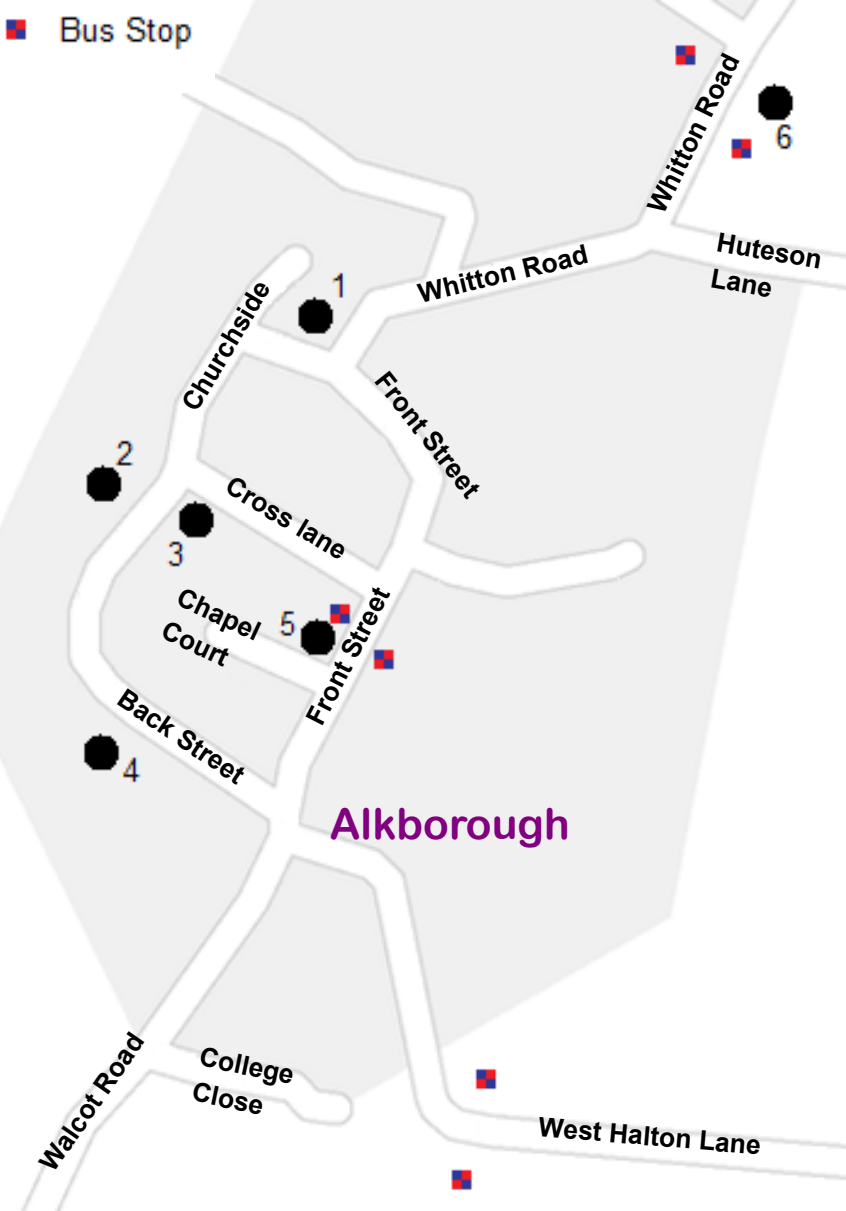

2 = Julian's Bower

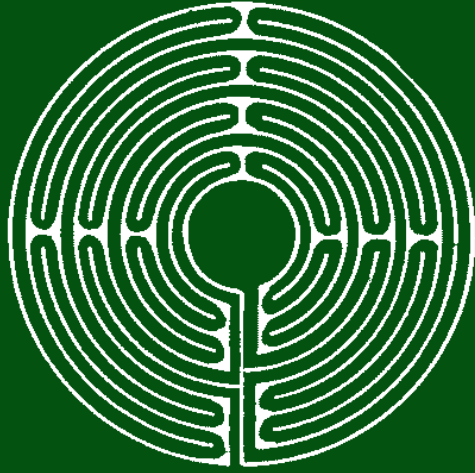
3 = Coronation Club
